Sub: Correction in the 'Guidelines for Presiding and Polling Officers for Conduct of Election to Karbi Anglong Autonomous Council, 2017' and regarding colour of Tendered and Postal Ballot papers.

Sir,

With reference to the subject as noted above, I am directed to refer to para 23(2) of the 'Guidelines for Presiding and Polling Officers for Conduct of Election to Karbi Anglong Autonomous Council, 2017' and to say that the portion under the Para 23(2) viz.

"A Tendered ballot paper shall be same other Ballot Papers used at the polling except that;

- a) **Such tendered ballot paper shall be serially the last in the bundle of ballot papers issued for use at the polling station; and"**

shall be substituted with the following :

"2) (a) A Tendered ballot paper shall be same as other Ballot Papers used at the polling."

Further the Commission decides that the colour of the normal Ballot Papers shall be **White**, that of Tendered Ballot Papers shall be **Blue** and of Postal Ballot Papers shall be **Pink**.

The Ballot Papers for Tendered Votes shall be guided by Rule 154 of the Assam Autonomous Districts (Constitution of District Councils) Rules, 1951. Printing of such Tendered Ballot Papers and also Postal Ballot Papers shall be done by the respective District Election Officer locally while the printing of regular Ballot Papers shall be done at Assam Govt. Press at Guwahati.
